Medical Emergency Team

The Medical Emergency Team (MET) at PMH provides a medical and nursing assessment of any child who requires urgent medical review. The MET is made up of specialist nurses and doctors.

Calling for help

How to request a Medical Emergency Team to review your child

Talk to a nurse or doctor about your concerns.

1

If you are still worried your child is becoming more unwell, talk to the nurse in charge (shift coordinator).

2

If you are still worried and not satisfied with the response, ask for a doctor to review your child.

3

If you are still worried and not satisfied with the response, ask the shift coordinator for a Medical Emergency Team (MET) review.

4

If you are still worried and not satisfied with the response, call 3133 (on a PMH phone line) or 6229 3133 to request a MET review. You will need to provide your name, the patient's name and the ward and bed number.
